

Fel ysgol rydym yn defnyddio cynllun Read Write Inc ar gyfer ein ffoneg Saesneg. Rhannwyd y synau sydd angen i ddarllen a sillafu yn Saesneg mewn i 3 set. Dechreuodd y plant dysgu set 1 ar ddiwedd blwyddyn 2. Ar ddechrau blwyddyn 3 rydym wedi eu adolygu ac erbyn hyn wedi symud ymlaen i ddechrau set.



We follow the Read Write Inc Phonics program for English. The sounds needed to read and spell in English are split into three sets.

Your child will have started learning set 1 at the end of year 2.

At the beginning of year 3 we recapped these sounds and also start learning to blend these sounds.

These are the Set 1 Speed Sounds written with one letter:

**m a s d t i n p g o c k u b f e l h r j v y w z x**

These are the sounds written with two letters (your child will call these 'special friends'):

**sh th ch qu ng nk ck**

**Check if your child can read these sounds. Make sure they say sounds like 'mmm', not letter names like 'em'.**

Your child is learning to read and spell words containing Set 1 Speed Sounds by sound blending. For example:

m-a-t mat

c-a-t cat

g-o-t got

f-i-sh fish

s-p-o-t spot

b-e-s-t best

s-p-l-a-sh splash.

Each week we will send home a set of example words linked to the sound of the week. The list is for them to do a little extra spelling and reading practise at home. They do not need to stick exclusively to the list, maybe your child could look for extra words in books. Equally if your child is unable to read or spell a lot of the words it is better to stick with a group of about 5 words to work on, substituting a word once they get it correct.

## Tricky Words

In addition to the spelling patterns we also work on sets of tricky words. These sets are ordered to go with the Read Write Inc books. We are currently working on set two.

When we move on to new sets of tricky words it's good to keep practising previous sets too. We will send a text home to let you know when we have moved to the next level.
